Parking: Team members are encouraged to car pool as limited parking is available at the Shooting Grounds.

Registration: Your team captain should check in at the registration tent upon arrival. The course and starting station will be assigned at registration.

Tournament Assembly: All shooters should assemble at 9:00 a.m. for tournament instructions and be at their starting station by 9:15 a.m. ready for the shotgun start on the course.

Shooter's Challenge: Participants are encouraged to purchase a Shooter's Challenge package the morning of the tournament. This package includes two mulligans for use at any time on the Sporting Clays Course and one raffle ticket for the opportunity to win a special prize.

Ammunition: Ammunition will be provided on the sporting clays course for 12 gauge and 20 gauge shotguns.

Gun Rental: Participants should bring their own shotguns for the tournament. A limited number will be available from Barnsley Gardens Resort. To reserve a shotgun please contact the Outpost at Barnsley Gardens at 770-773-9229.

Shooting Safety: All shooters are required to wear eye and ear protection on the sporting clays course. Both eye and ear protection will be available at the tournament for any shooter who needs them.
